

PTS Barricade User Manual

1. Congratulations



Owning a Portable Tactical Simulated Barricade (PTSB) is a solid investment in learning how to use environmental barriers to your advantage in the event of a defensive encounter! The following guide applies to all of the PTSB full-size models including PTSB, PTSB16, PTSB24, PTSB-Pro, PTSB-Sniper, and PTSB-Breach.

2. Remove Barricade from Box



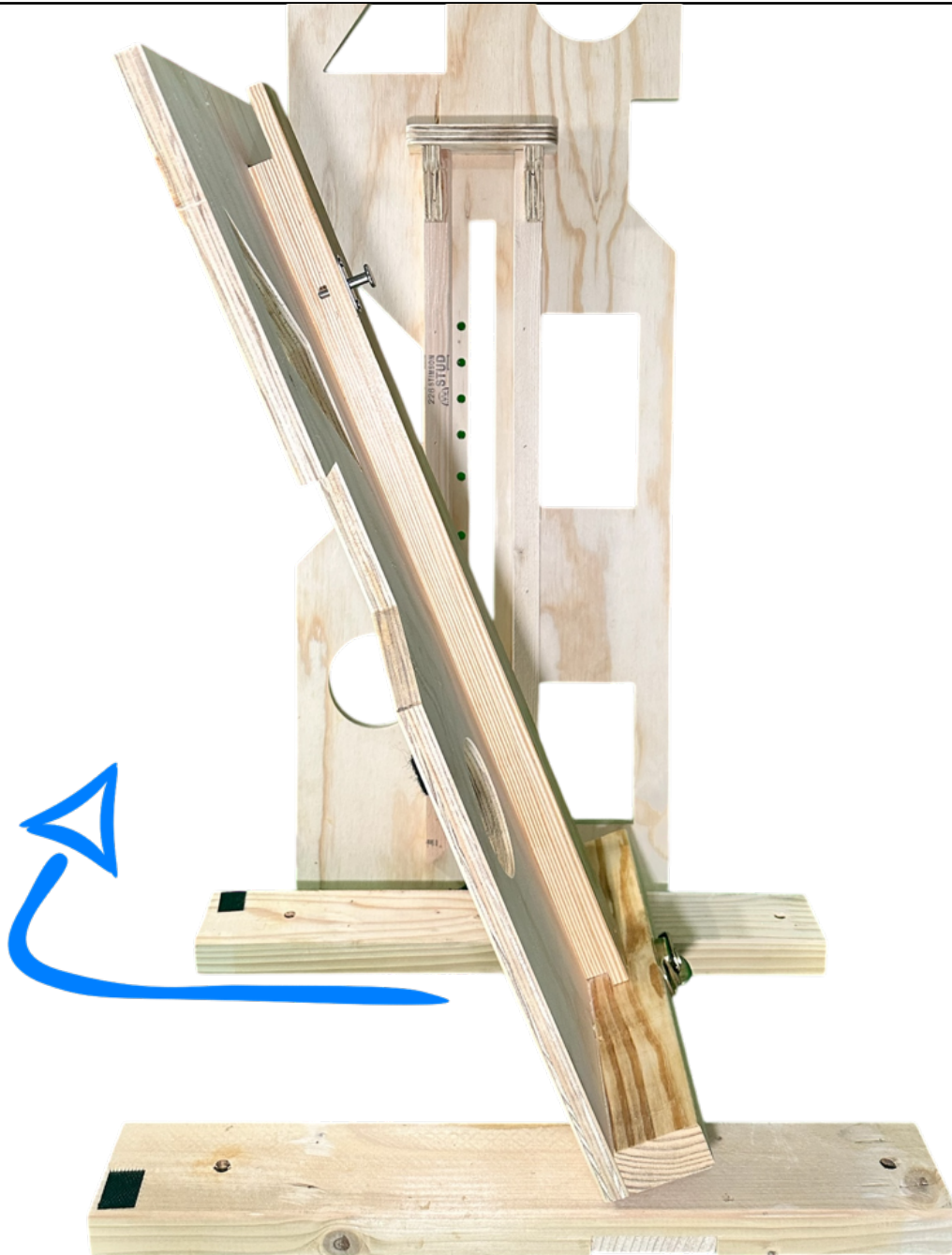
Remove packing material, then remove the contents of the box. This includes the two parts of the barricade, the base barricade with legs and the detachable barricade.

3. Dislodge Velcro



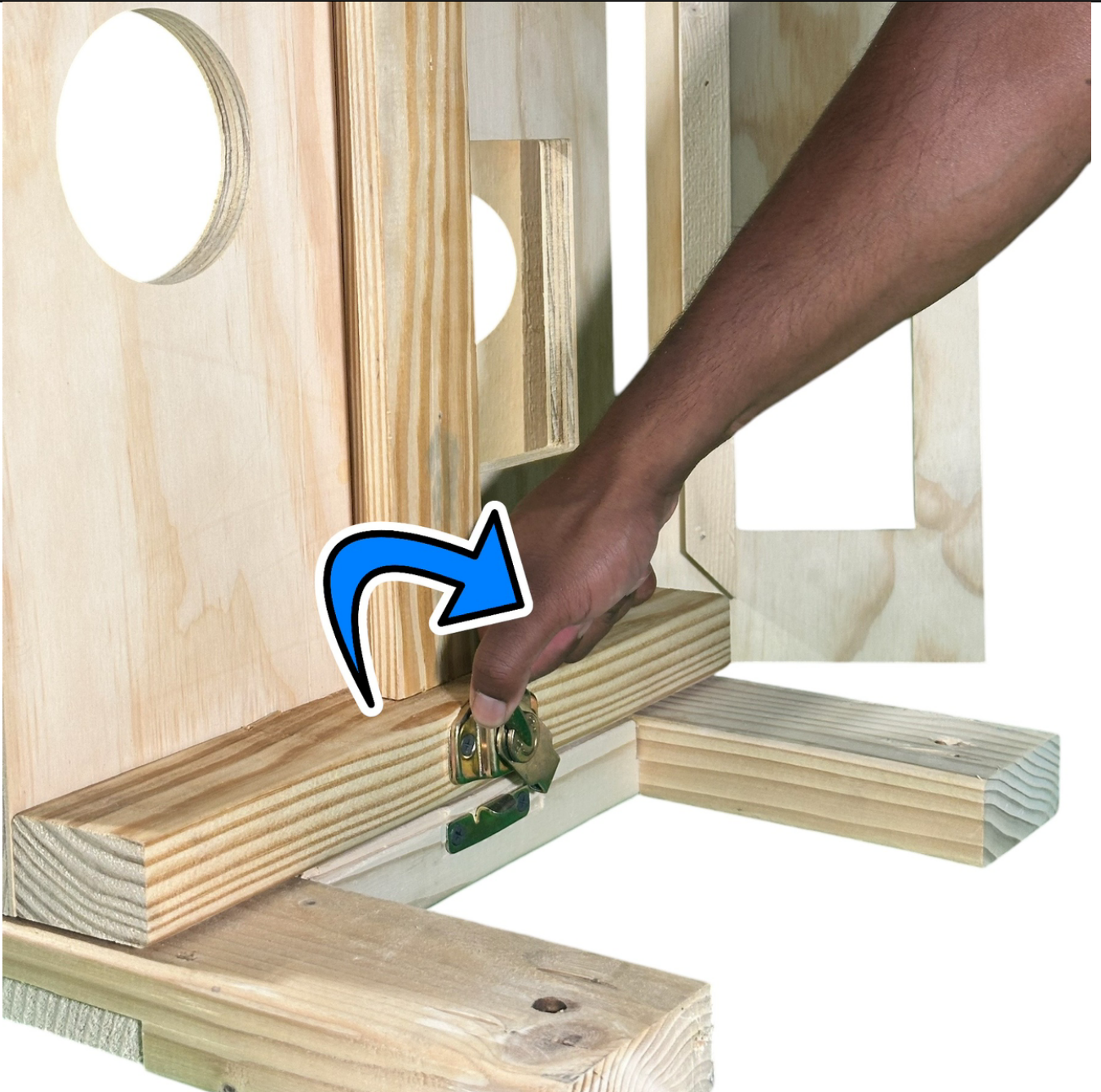
The base barricade ships with the folding leg locked in place against the barrier by Velcro strips. Separate Velcro fasteners to release the leg.

4. Setup Base Barricade



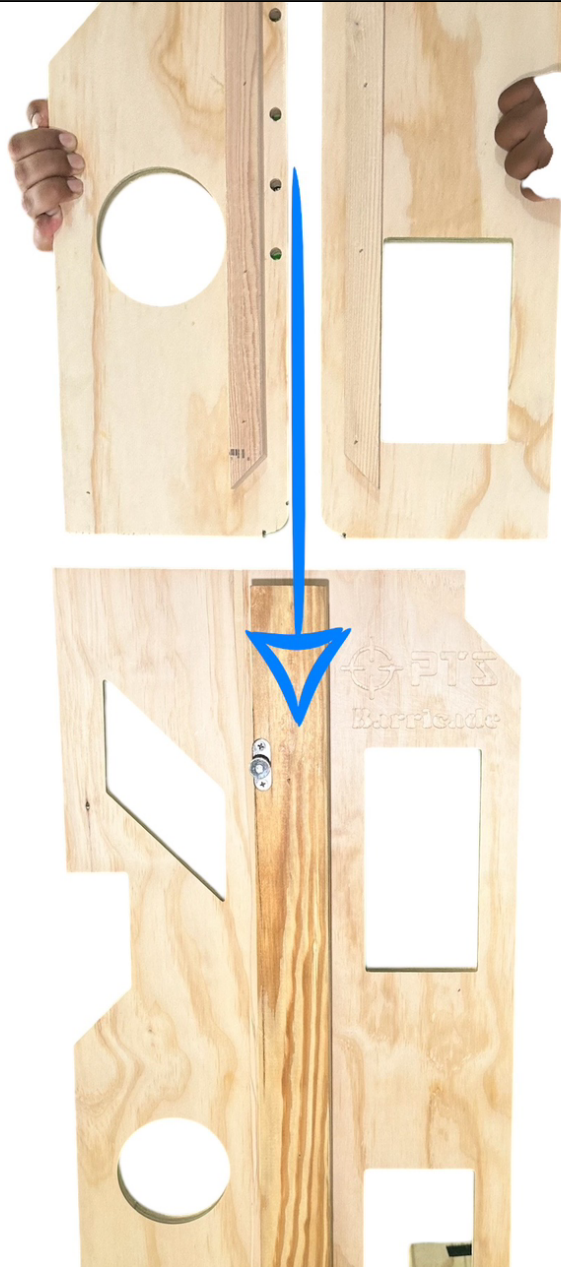
Rotate the leg so that it is perpendicular to the barrier then place it on a table or the floor.

5. Securely Lock the Leg



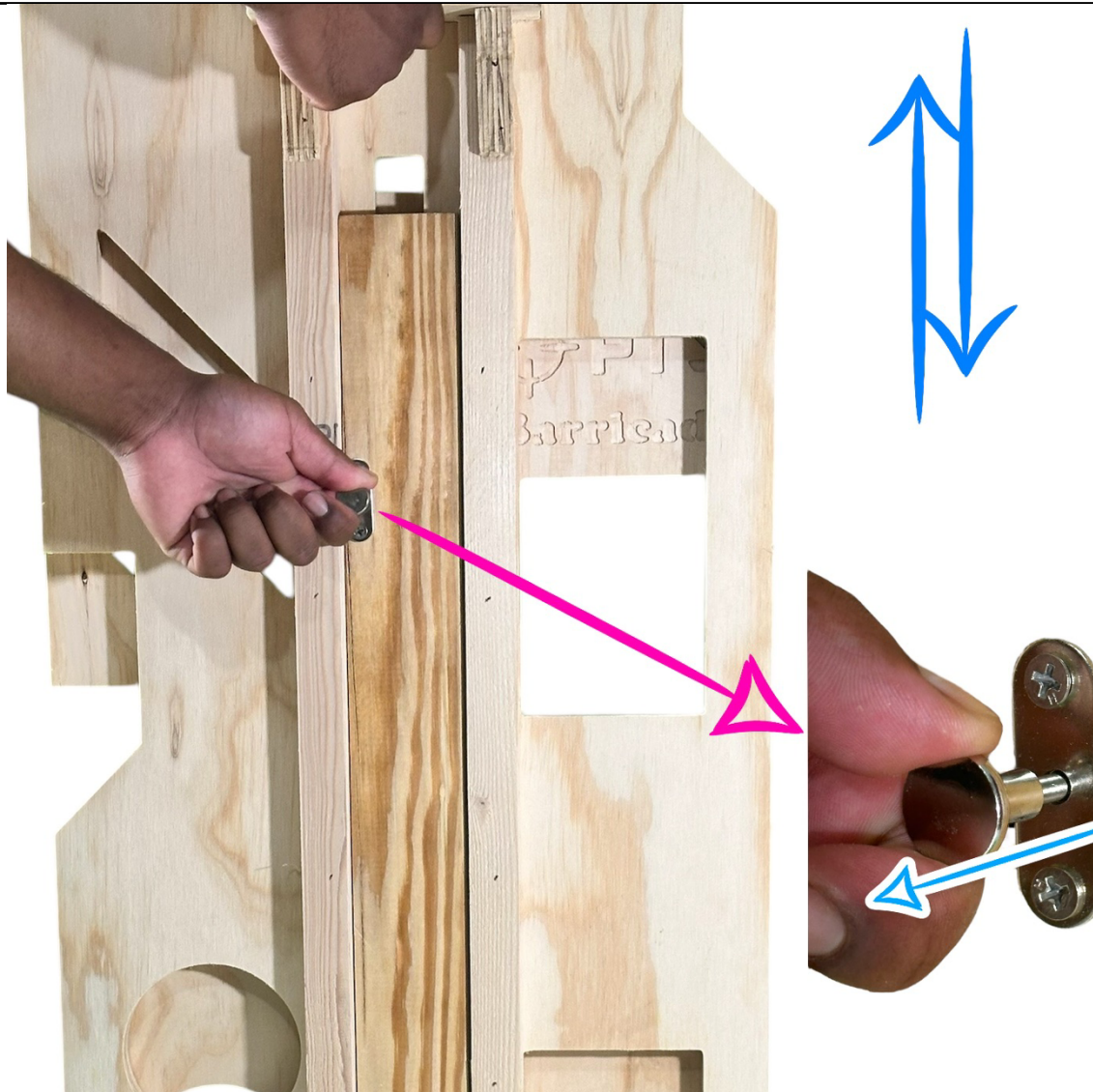
Lock the leg in place by rotating the handle of the sash lock counterclockwise.

6. Attach Detachable Barricade



Align the 2 parts of the barricade so that the detachable portion slides vertically along the center guide of the detachable barricade.

7. Adjust height



Adjust the height of the barricade as needed by pulling the knob of the dowel lock. Pull the knob while raising or lowering the detachable portion then simultaneously releasing the knob so that it selects the next adjustment slot milled into barrier.

8. Select Desired Challenge



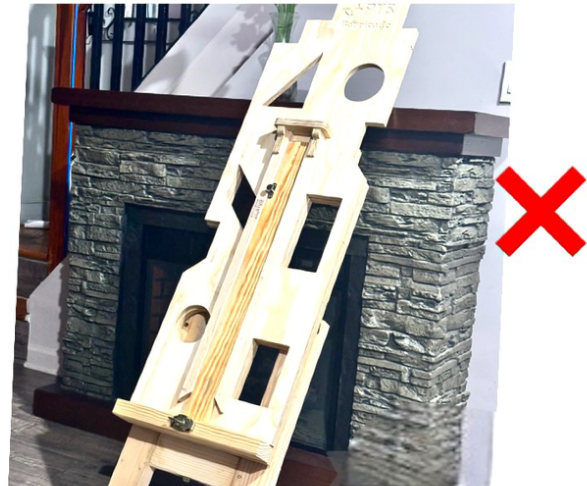
Adjusting the height of the barricade also changes the sizes and shapes of the cut-outs used to acquire a target down range. This provides the user with an interactive, active learning experience.

9. Safety Tips



1. Use only the handle on the detachable barricade in conjunction with the dowel lock to adjust the height of the barricade. Never place fingers or other body parts in the cut-outs to make height adjustments or in the path of the detachable barricade.
2. Wear proper clothing, including shoes when handling the barricade.
3. Check to make sure that the barrier is locked firmly against the leg with the sash lock before using the barricade.
4. Always wear a glove when handling wood and plywood material as there is a possibility of splinters coming loose.

10. Caring for My Barricade: Storage/Shipping



The longevity of the PTSB depends largely on how it used and stored the following tips may help you to get the most out of your investment.

When storing/transporting the barricade, place it in such away to support its natural shape in order to avoid excessive bending or wharping.

11. Caring for my Barricade: Lubrication



PTSB's are made largely of wood and plywood and therefore are subjected to contraction and expansion depending on the environment where they are stored or used. Sometimes excessive expansion may reduce the ease with which the detachable portion slides up/down. Adding lubricant in the sliding tract may promote smoother sliding during height adjustment.

12. Caring for My Barricade: After Shooting



After a day at the range, the barricade can be discolored with gunpowder residue. A variety of methods can be used to clean your barricade, including:

1. Gun cleaning solvent
2. Microfiber cloth or lint-free rags
3. Cleaning patches
4. Nylon brushes.
